7. List of accidents in the last 5 years and the steps taken and Action Taken Report.
8. Status of constitution of District and Local Crisis Groups alongwith contact details of crisis group members.
9. Name, designation and contact details of key personnel dealing with chemical emergencies.

It is requested to provide above information of districts falling under your jurisdiction to enable us to respond to the Ministry in time.

Sir/Madam

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India is implementing two sets of Rules under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, namely Manufacture, Storage and Import of Hazardous Chemicals (MSIHC Rules), 1989 & the Chemical Accidents (Emergency, Planning, Preparedness and Response) Rules, 1996. In this regard, it is requested to furnish the following:

- Updated District-wise list of Major Accident Hazard Units (MAH); indicating the hazardous chemicals handled, stored and transported (as on 30th November, 2023), along with a copy of successive insurance policies under the Public Liability Insurance (PLI) Act, 1991.
 - Status of Off-site Plan available in the districts (as on 30th November, 2023);
 - Status of the On-site Emergency Plans prepared by the occupier (as on 30th November, 2023);
 - Safety Audits conducted by the Unit and by the external agency-details thereof
 - Details of mock-drills conducted by the MAH units
 - List of Accidents in the past 5 years and the steps taken by the State Government (up to 30th November, 2023) and Action taken report.
 - Status of Constitution of State, District and Local Level Crisis Groups (as on 30th November, 2023).
 - Name, Designation and Contact Details of Key Personnel dealing with the Chemicals Emergencies.
2. It is further requested that the information may be furnished at the earliest, preferably by 25th January, 2023. A copy of the Performa is enclosed herewith for reference.
