The World Ozone Day is celebrated on 16th September every year, commemorating the date of signing of Montreal Protocol, a global agreement to protect Stratospheric ozone layer. The Montreal Protocol addresses phasing out the production and consumption of ozone depleting substances and is considered as a successful multilateral environmental treaty.

The theme for the World Ozone Day 2022 is "**Montreal Protocol@35: global cooperation protecting life on earth**". The theme recognizes the wider impact the Montreal Protocol has on climate change and the need to act in collaboration, forge partnerships and develop global cooperation to address climate challenges and protect life on earth for future generations.

India, as Party to the Vienna Convention for the Protection of the Ozone Layer and its Montreal Protocol, has played a proactive role in the phasing out of production and consumption of ozone depleting substances in the country and adhered to all the phase out schedules of the Montreal Protocol by demonstrating commitment towards protection of the climate and the environment.

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has also developed and launched the India Cooling Action Plan (ICAP) during 2019, which lists out actions, inter-alia, reduction of cooling demand, refrigerant transition to low global warming etc. Actions emerging from the recommendations of the ICAP, especially in the building sector, can significantly contribute to India's climate target in achieving the net zero emissions by 2070. In this context, I request you to issue necessary instructions in your State/ UT to promote awareness on Ozone Layer depletion as well as on the actions emerging from the recommendations of the India Cooling Action Plan. 

The United Nations General Assembly on 23rd January 1995 adopted resolution, 49/114, which proclaims 16th September as the World Ozone Day, commemorating the date on which Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer was signed in 1987. The Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer, is a global agreement to protect stratospheric ozone layer by phasing out the production and consumption, including uses of chemicals that deplete it.

2. India, as a Party to the Vienna Convention for the Protection of the Ozone Layer and the Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer and all its amendments, has been successfully implementing the phase-out programme for Ozone Depleting Substances (ODSs) in the country. India is now phasing out the Hydrochlorofluorocarbons (HCFCs) as per the accelerated phase-out schedule of the Montreal Protocol and has already met 2015 and 2020 phase-out targets. The complete phase-out of production and consumption of HCFCs will be by 2030 with a service tail of 2.5% annual average during the period 2030-2040. Hydrofluorocarbons, commonly known as HFCs have been included as controlled substances under the Montreal Protocol through the Kigali Amendment to the Montreal Protocol in 2016. India ratified the Kigali Amendment to the Montreal Protocol during September 2021 and will have to complete its phase down the production and consumption of HFCs in 4 steps from 2032 onwards with reduction of 10% in 2032, 20% in 2037, 30% in 2042 and 85% in 2047 respectively.

3. The theme for the celebration of **World Ozone Day 2022** on 16th September 2022 is "**Montreal Protocol@35: global cooperation protecting life on earth**". The theme recognises the wider impact the Montreal Protocol has on climate change and the need to act in collaboration, forge partnerships and develop global cooperation to address climate challenges and protect life on earth for future generations.

4. The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has developed and launched the India Cooling Action Plan (ICAP) during 2019 which lists out actions, inter-alia reduction of cooling demand, refrigerant transition to low global warming potential alternatives, enhancing energy efficiency and better technology options over a 20 year time horizon through synergizing with on-going programmes of the Government. 
